ENEL GROUP PARTICIPATES IN THE 80TH UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN NEW YORK

Rome-New York, September 25th, 2025 – The Enel Group participated in the 80th **United Nations General Assembly** and the **UN High-Level Week** currently under way in New York, which brought together global leaders. The Group's top management participated in high-profile discussions, underscoring its commitment to accelerating sustainable investment and inclusive growth through public-private collaboration. Enel emphasized the vital role of business in shaping a resilient global economy and advancing the energy transition through strategic partnerships.
