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### ENEL'S RENEWABLE GROWTH STRATEGY CONTINUES IN ITALY THROUGH THE ACQUISITION OF AN 84 MW WIND FARM

- *The consideration for the acquisition amounts to approximately 145 million euros, corresponding to the enterprise value attributed to the facility*
- *A positive contribution to the Group's results (ordinary EBITDA) of approximately 16 million euros per year is expected*
- *The transaction is coherent with the Enel Group's strategy, which envisages accelerating growth of its generation capacity from renewable sources including through the acquisition of assets already in operation in Tier 1 countries (Brownfield)*

**Rome, July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026** – Enel S.p.A. ("Enel"), through its wholly owned subsidiary Enel Green Power Italia S.r.l., has signed and finalized an agreement with WEB Ariano S.r.l., a company owned by WEB Windenergie AG, for the acquisition of 100% of the share capital of Campo Eolico Ariano – CEA S.r.l. which owns and operates a wind farm located in the Campania region of Italy, with a total installed capacity of 84 MW and an average annual output of approximately 0.2 TWh. The consideration for the acquisition, corresponding to the enterprise value attributed to the facility, amounts to approximately 145 million euros.

The acquisition is expected to generate a positive net impact on the Enel Group's consolidated ordinary EBITDA of approximately 16 million euros per year.

The transaction is coherent with the Enel Group's strategy, which envisages accelerating growth of its generation capacity from renewable sources including through the acquisition of assets already in operation in Tier 1 countries (Brownfield).
